

FSCC Event Description

Some of you may have questions regarding the competition and accommodations. Following is a brief description that I hope to answer some of questions you and your students might have:

The Event:

Registration: 30 students are allowed for each school. Event registration will be done online go2fsc.weebly.com, but we need each student/parent to submit the consent form first.

Individual Competition: Each student will compete in academic events, speaking, reading, and listening. Each student will receive a certificate for each event he/she compete in recognition of their performance. Study materials/guidelines are provided on go2fsc.weebly.com

Team Competition - Jeopardy: Each school/division will select four students to represent your school to compete in the jeopardy contest. Students cannot collaborate when playing jeopardy. This contest is administered in English. This is the only competition event. **Chinese Heritage Students are not allowed to be part of Jeopardy game.**

Cultural Performance: This is the fun part! We get to see each school put on a Chinese language or culture related mini-performance. We look forward to seeing the students perform! Each schools will choose the topic on site and have the opportunity to show team work and create the performance on the spot. Each performance is limited to 3 minutes or less. There will be 2 best performance elected by FCTA board members.

Project Exhibits: It's a wonderful opportunity for students to show off what they have learned from Chinese courses. Each school is allowed to bring in 3 pieces of student projects for exhibition. The projects must be new and never been showed in the previous competition. All projects will be displayed in a room that allows students and teachers to visit during their free time. There will be 2 best project be elected.

Other Things:

Meals: If you are staying in the hotel of Lake Yale, your registration also included the Friday banquet dinner and Saturday breakfast, and lunch. If you are staying in another hotel, your Friday dinner and Saturday Lunch is included. Students may bring along some pocket money to purchase snacks and souvenirs.
